Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 56,700 Jobs Year Over Year in August 2023 Arizona Unemployment Increased to 3.8%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate increased to 3.8% in August 2023 from 3.6% in July 2023. The U.S. SA unemployment rate increased to 3.8% in August 2023 from 3.5% in July 2023.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 8,321 individuals, or 0.2%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 65,786 individuals, or 1.8%.

Month over month, Arizona not-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 49,700 jobs. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 56,700 jobs, or 1.8%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 6,400 individuals, or 0.2%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 49,700 jobs in August. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), NSA nonfarm employment gained 54,000 jobs on average in August. The private sector recorded a gain of 18,000 jobs in August, led by gains in Private Education & Health Services (8,800 jobs) and Professional & Business Services (6,000 jobs). Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 18,400 jobs in August. The government sector¹ recorded a gain of 31,700 jobs in August, more than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 35,600 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector occurred primarily within Local Government Education (22,300 jobs).



Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 56,700 jobs or 1.8% in August year over year. Private sector employment increased by 42,200 jobs year over year, while government employment increased by 14,500 jobs year over year.







Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate




Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment





Year-to-Year Percent Change




Arizona & U.S. Employment Services Year-to-Year Percent Change




Arizona & U.S. Health Care
