Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 111,500 Jobs Year Over Year in November 2022 Arizona Unemployment increased to 4.1%

The Arizona seasonally adjusted (SA) unemployment rate increased to 4.1% in November 2022 from 3.9% in October 2022. The U.S. SA unemployment rate remained at 3.7% in November 2022, unchanged from October 2022.

Month over month, Arizona's SA labor force increased by 6,407 individuals, or 0.2%. Year over year, the SA labor force increased by 92,323 individuals, or 2.6%.

Month over month, Arizona non-seasonally adjusted (NSA) total nonfarm employment increased by 32,300 jobs or 1.0%¹. Year over year, NSA total nonfarm employment increased by 111,500 jobs, or 3.7%. Arizona SA total nonfarm employment increased by 7,000 individuals, or 0.2%, month over month.

Month Over Month

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 32,300 jobs or 1.0% in November. Prior to the pandemic, NSA nonfarm employment averaged a gain of 28,800 jobs in November (2010-2019). The government sector² recorded a gain of 6,100 jobs in November, more than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 1,600 jobs. Employment gains in the government sector were led by gains in local government. The private sector recorded a gain of 26,200 jobs in November, led by gains in Trade, Transportation & Utilities and Education & Health Services. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 27,200 jobs in November.



The employment estimates used to calculate the unemployment rate come from a different survey than the survey used to estimate total nonfarm employment. For November, total nonfarm employment was estimated to be much higher than the employment and labor force estimates used to calculate the unemployment rate.

The government sector includes public K-12 education and public postsecondary education. Education & Health Services includes private sector education.



Year Over Year

Arizona NSA nonfarm employment increased by 111,500 jobs or 3.7% in November year-over-year. Private sector employment increased by 102,200 jobs year-over-year, while government employment increased by 9,300 jobs year-over-year.



Year-to-Year Percent Change




Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment Year-to-Year Percent Change

Year-to-Year Percent Change




Arizona & U.S. Employment Services Year-to-Year Percent Change
