Total Nonfarm Employment Increased by 106,700 Jobs Year Over Year in September 2022 Arizona Unemployment increased to 3.7%

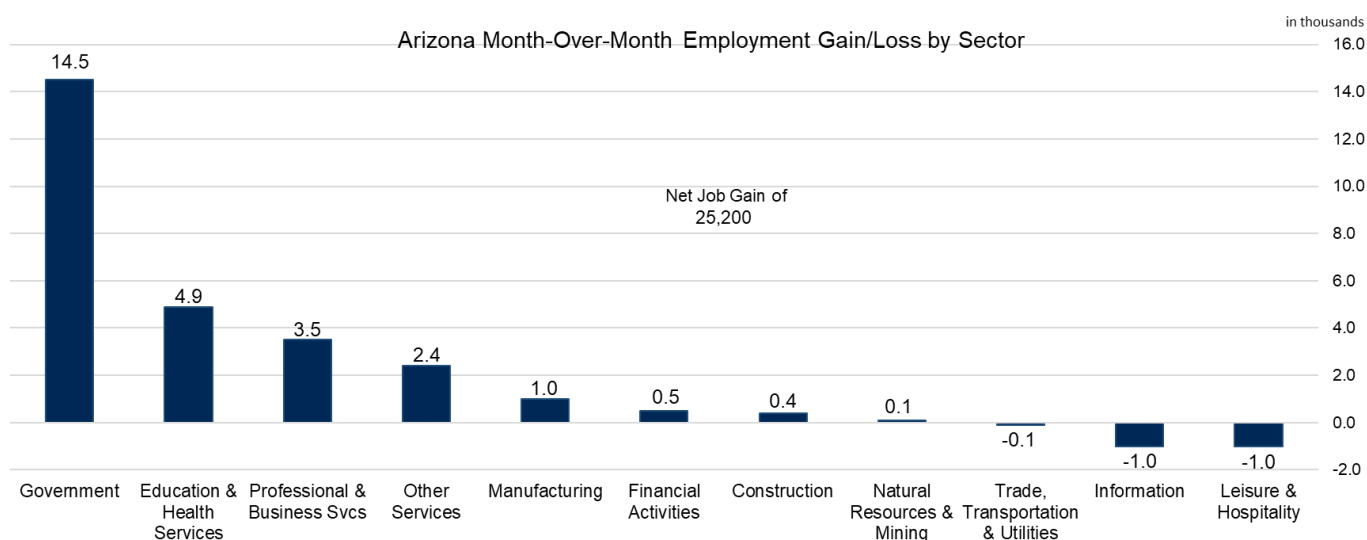
The Arizona seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 3.7% in September 2022 from 3.5% in August 2022. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased to 3.5% in September 2022 from 3.7% in August 2022. Month over month, Arizona's seasonally adjusted labor force increased by 11,717 individuals or 0.3%. Year over year, the labor force increased by 78,411 individuals or 2.2%. Month over month, Arizona total nonfarm employment increased by 25,200 jobs or 0.8%. Year over year, total nonfarm employment increased by 106,700 jobs or 3.6%.

Month Over Month

Arizona nonfarm employment increased by 25,200 jobs or 0.8% in September. Prior to the pandemic, nonfarm employment averaged a gain of 28,800 jobs in September (2010-2019). The government sector¹ recorded a gain of 14,500 jobs in September, less than the pre-pandemic (2010-2019) average gain of 23,300 jobs. The private sector recorded a gain of 10,700 jobs in September, led by gains in Education & Health Services. Prior to the pandemic (2010-2019), private sector employment averaged a gain of 5,500 jobs in September.

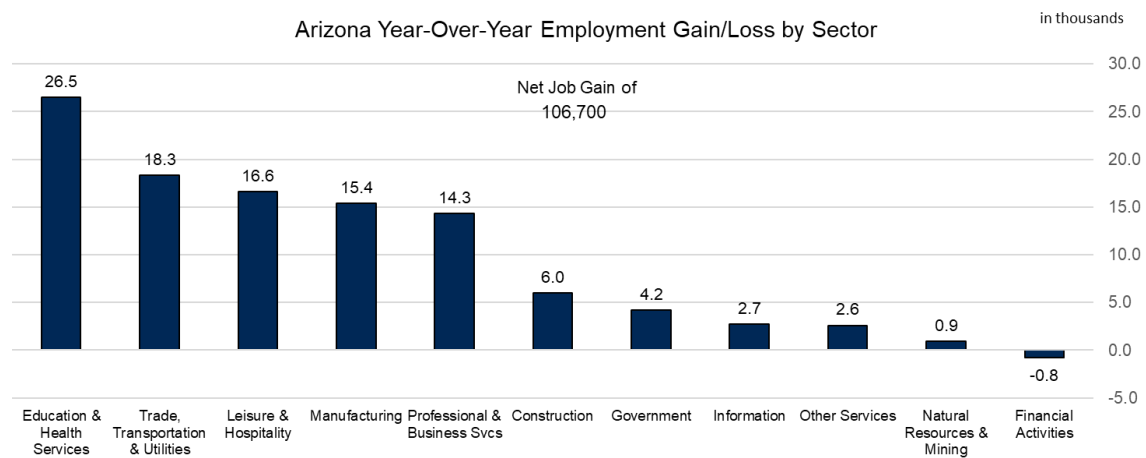
Arizona nonfarm employment increased by 106,700 jobs or 3.6% in September year-over-year. Private sector employment increased by 102,500 jobs year-over-year, while government employment increased by 4,200 jobs year-over-year.

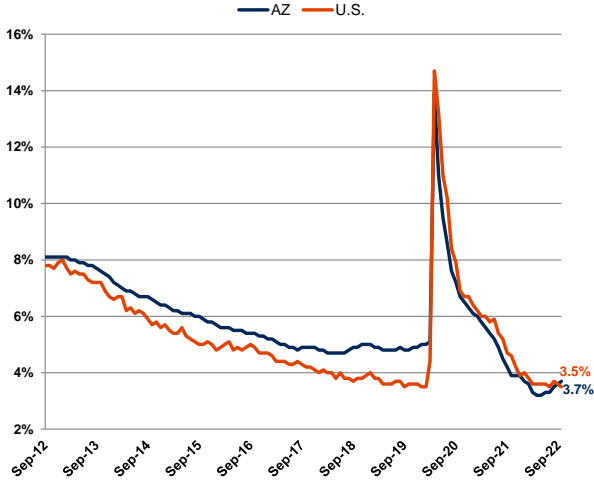

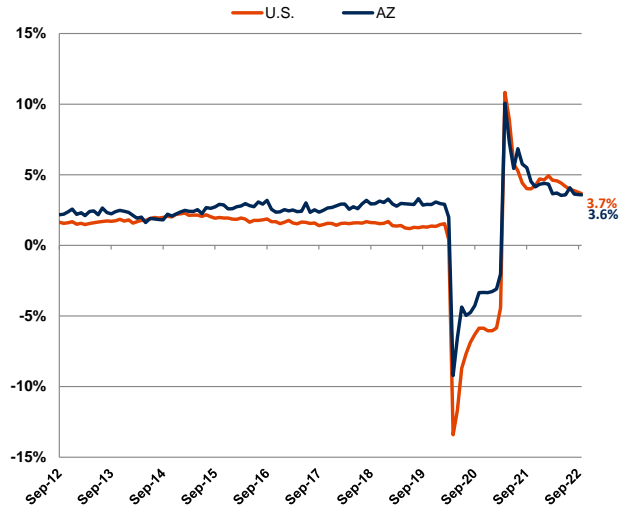

Seasonally Adjusted

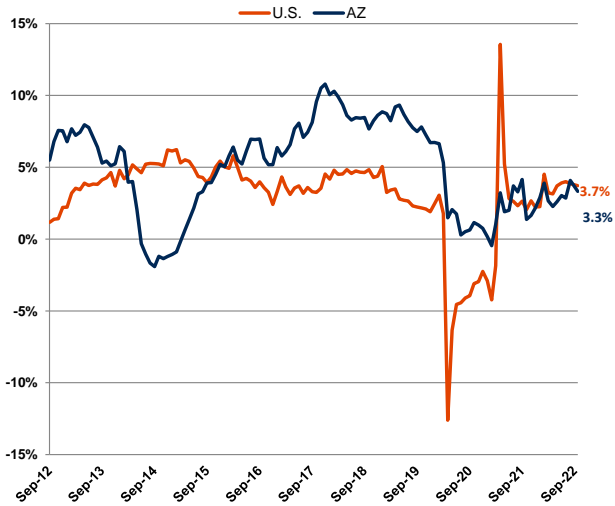


Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change

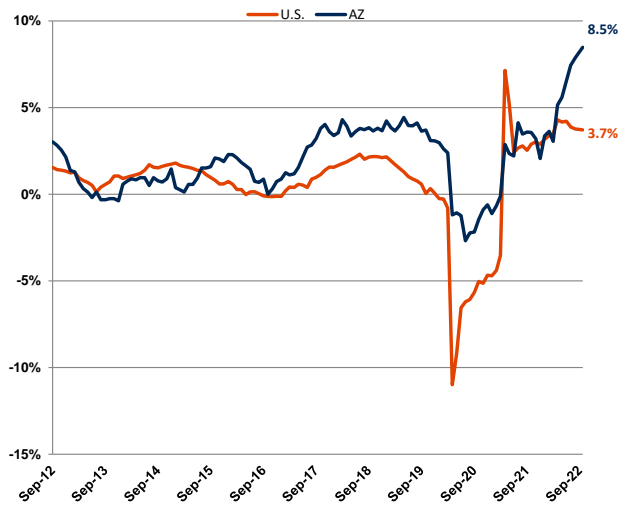


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Arizona & U.S. Construction Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change



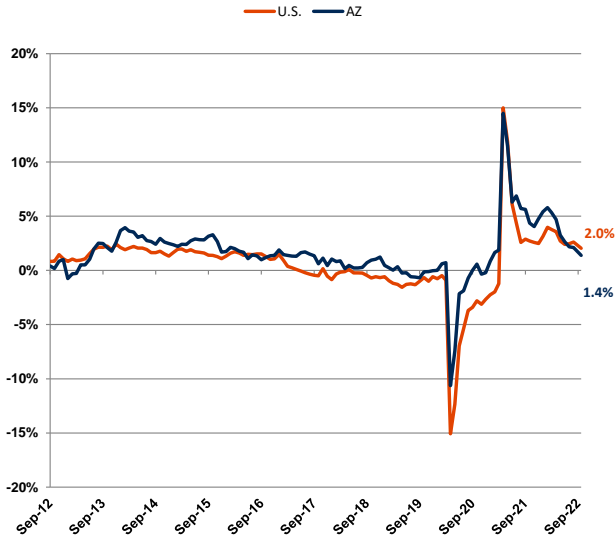
Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change



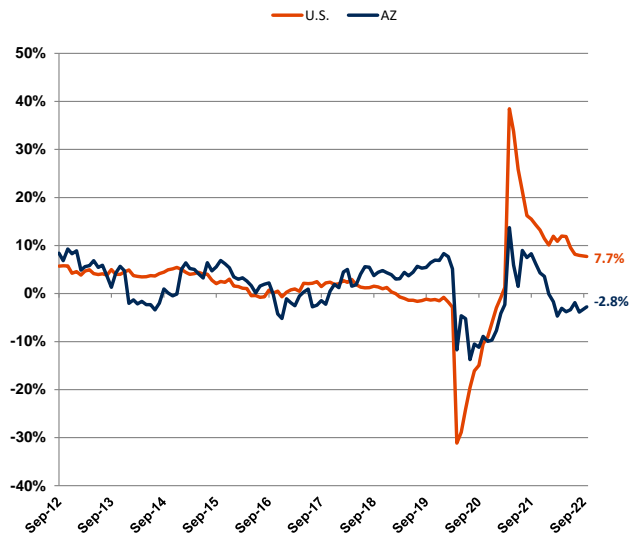

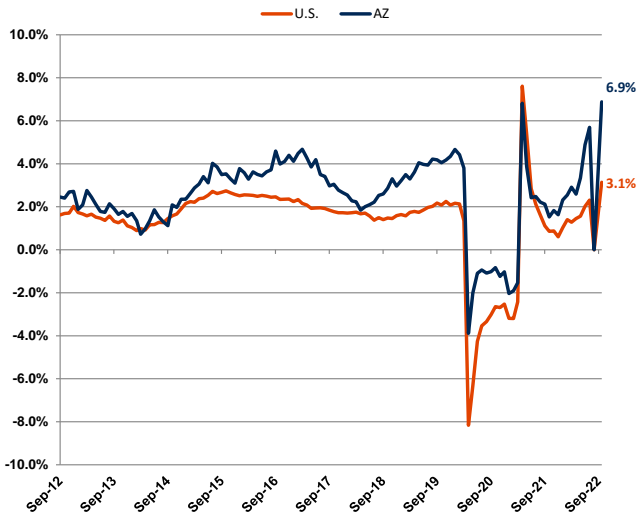
Arizona & U.S. Retail Trade
Year-to-Year Percent Change



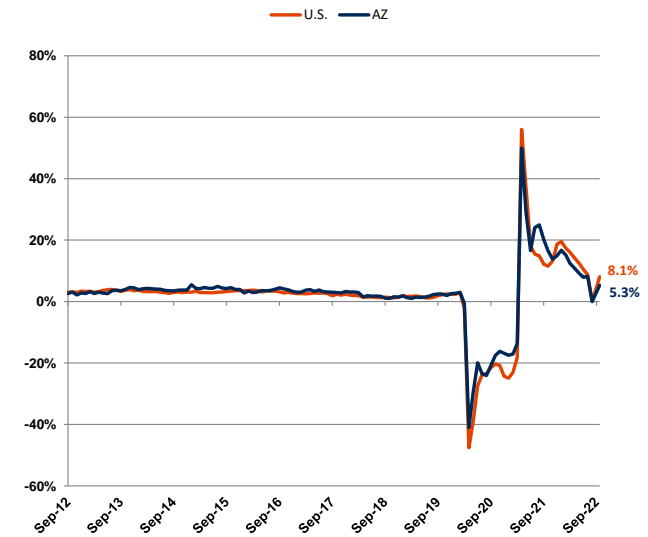
Arizona & U.S. Employment Services
